- 1. As a coverslip, so giving direct measurements.
- 2. As a counting grid.
- 3. As an eyepiece reticle just cut to the diameter required to fit in your eyepiece guide circles are included (FNE1 only).
- 4. As a stage micrometer to calibrate your microscope.
- 5. As a specimen support.
- 6. As a direct reading scale with magnifiers.
